- 5. **Clerks reports** added to website with agendas and minutes.
- 7. **Finances.** Budget added to Dec 6 agenda. FYI Clerk is now an authorised signatory and is registered for online banking.
- 8. **Speeding, verge damage and lengthsman scheme**. Item included in next Dec 6 agenda. Clerk has identified locations of static radars and forwarded to Highways. Rob Graves included in communications. No response.

Clerk has contributed an article about the Highway Code with reference to speeding and parking issues to the school newsletter. Highways has also been asked to repaint the lines around the school to reduce parking on the junction.

Clerk hs requested meeting with Highways but no response received so far.

Clerk has contacted Cllr Nigel Moor re: Lengthsman scheme. The scheme starts again in May and Temple Guiting has been included in the list of applicants.

9. **Phoneboxes and post box**. Clerk has sent cheque to BT to buy the 2 boxes. Clerk has checked Council's insurance and public liability is already included.
